Order: Odonata

- Dragonflies are **predators**.
- Dragonfly nymphs use their **long grasping mouthparts** to grab prey.

My favorite snack include stonefly and mayfly larvae.



Brook Trout

- Brook trout are **predators**.
- These fish are known to eat insects, snails, worms, and even other fish!
- Brook trout live in clear, cool streams.

I have a big appetite for midges and caddisfly larvae.

Long-horned Caddisfly

Order: Trichoptera

- Long-horned caddisflies are **shredders** feeding on leaves in the stream.
- They make **protective cases** out of plants to protect themselves.

I have strong jaws that chew up large leaves!



Non-biting Midge

Family: Chironomidae

I snack on algae in leaves in the stream!

- Midges are **collectors** and eat tiny pieces of food.
- Midges are a great **food source for fish** in streams!

Order: Ephemeroptera

- Flat-headed mayflies are **scrapers**.
- They eat by scraping algae off of rocks and other surfaces.
- These mayflies can be found in **fast flowing streams**.

My favorite thing to do is cling to rocks and munch on green algae.



Winter Stonefly

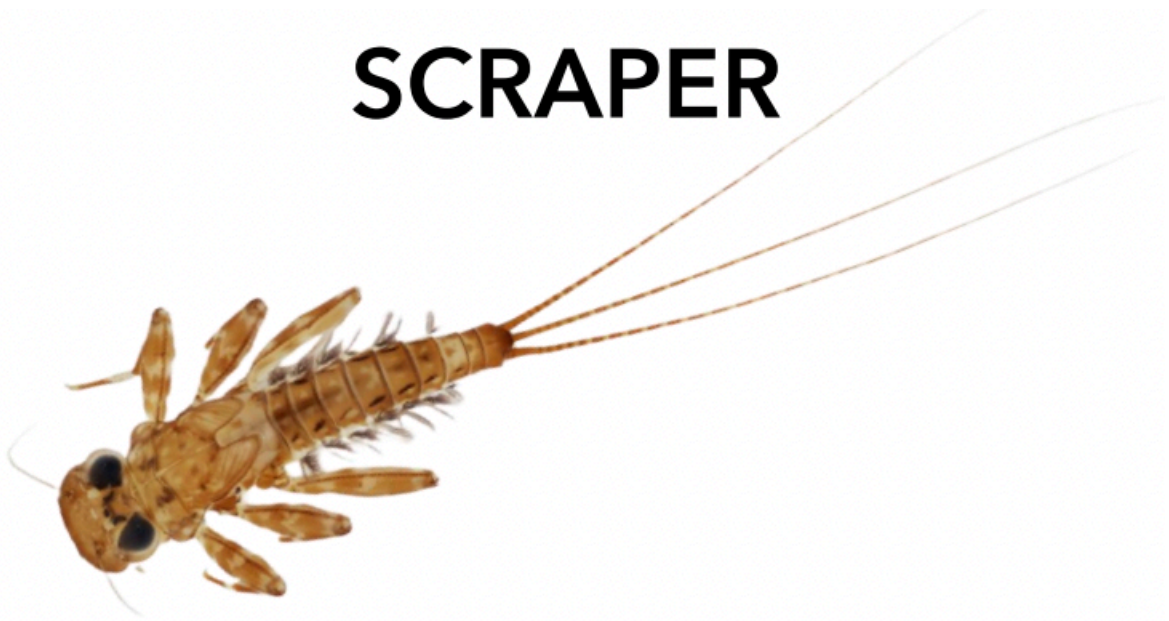
Order: Plecoptera

My favorite season of the year is winter time!



- Winter stoneflies are **shredders** and **shred leaves and algae** to eat.
- Winter stoneflies emerge as winged adults in the winter.
